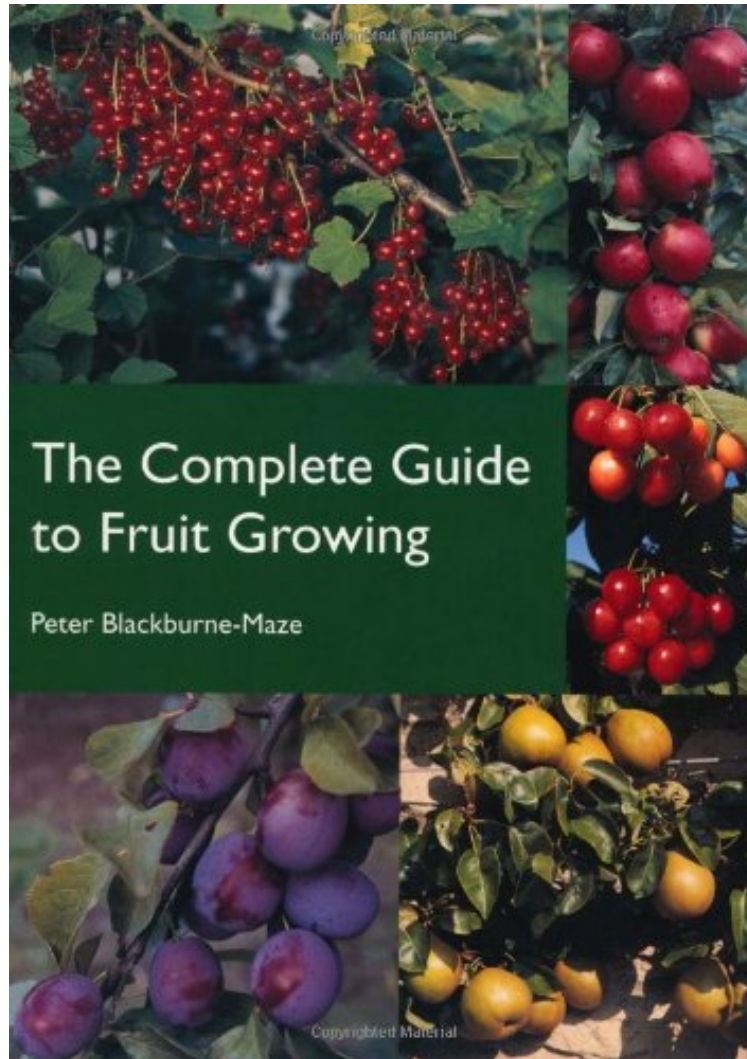

All references to weather patterns, varieties, plant nurseries, and other resources are strictly limited to the UK. Well written, and well illustrated, this relatively short book is designed for home gardeners. There is also one short chapter on greenhouse fruit. You can plant the varieties they recommend and probably be a happy and successful UK backyard gardener. A good introduction to the topic, but certainly not a complete guide.
