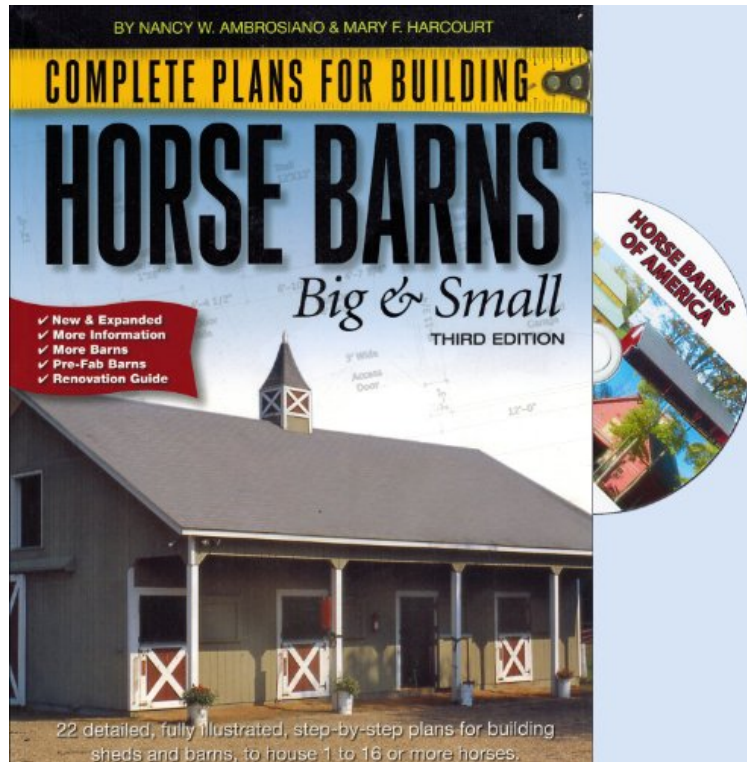

It has good information, but the title is very misleading. It does not have "complete" plans for building. It had a floor plan, materials list, and elevations for each barn. It doesn't have a SINGLE monitor-style (raised center aisle) barn. Considering that is one of the most popular horse barns, that seem pretty darned odd to me.
