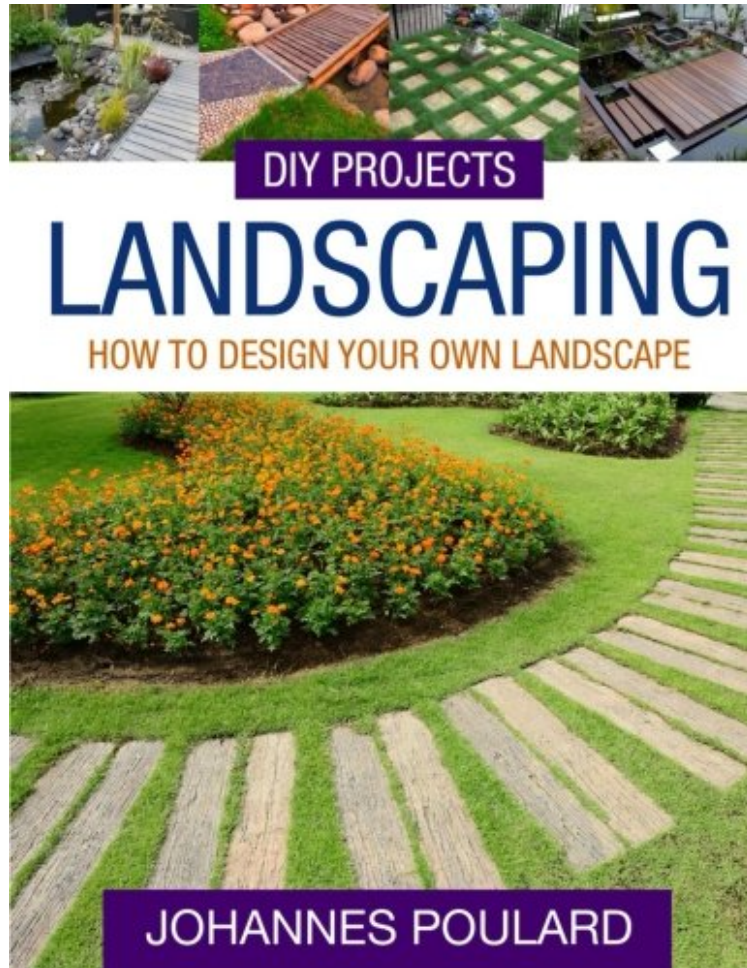

It tries to cover a huge number of topics, so really only includes a couple of sentences in each one and doesn't actually tell you how to do much of anything. It's more like a glossary of landscaping terms, and - despite the title - doesn't teach you anything about design. It's also riddled with typos, editing errors, and formatting mistakes.
