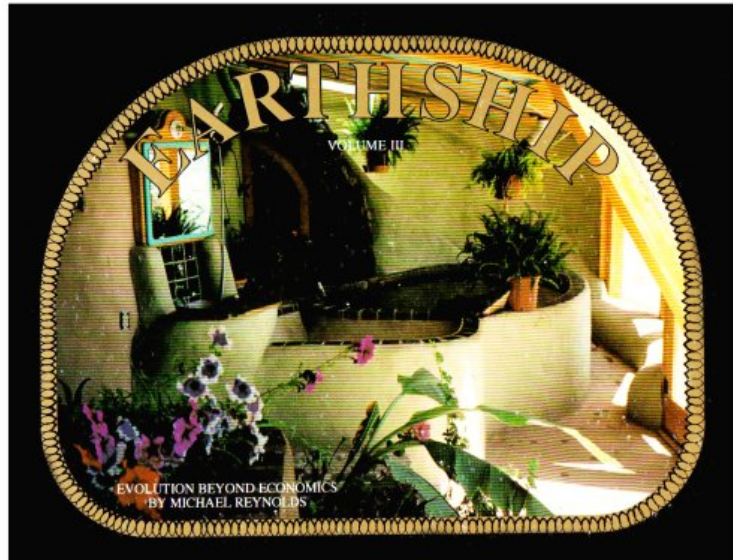

I love many of the ideas of earthships, including using waste tires for something constructive, building my own house, having food-growing considerations included, heating/cooling using solar and earth, and water-catching and purifying all built into the structure. Now Im more interested in straw bale because it seems less labor-intensive than packing earth into tires via a sledgehammer - which is the one idea that wouldn't work for me personally.
