(It is the one with a brown cover with several old texts piled on top of each other.) The binding is cheap and the large notebook size is not as convenient as a regular-sized paperback. I wanted to buy this book as a gift so I ordered the one printed by Cassia Press (it is the one with a white cover with purple flowers). The Cassia Press version is much nicer (and a little less expensive). I looked through

Von Arnim (she wrote "Enchanted April" and other novels) is a fascinating woman, a lady who shunned city-life for an isolated house in the country. She spends her days enjoying nature and her garden and much prefers the solitude over visitors. The first half of the book deals mostly with her experiences learning about her garden and growing various plants. She veers off a bit in the last part of the book and goes into much detail about a young female houseguest.
