I am no longer in touch with that person, and have been missing it sorely ever since. Great dcor ideas for how to transform rooms with fabrics -- curtains, sheers, shades, also some tips on pillows, fabric screens, etc. Author Melanie Paine's directions and the accompanying illustrations are impeccable. I hadn't sewn for ~20 years when I decided to make curtains, and this is the book I got and used.I made box-pleat caf drapes in a crisp semi-sheer striped cotton, with a triple-layer hem with weights at the bottom. Simple! Easy to measure and make! And gosh did they look expensive. Also made several Austrian shades (the ones that create swags when you raise them), LINED, and those too were a snap. Sewing curtains is mostly sewing straight lines, and Paine takes you through it step by step.I am now purchasing the book again, that's how much I love it. A must-have, and you will be amazed how much you can accomplish with a ruler, a pair of scissors, a sewing machine (or even just needle and thread -- I've

made curtains from this book entirely by hand). Highly recommend!
