When I first read through it, I thought that none of the plants applied to me.It's pretty much an "idea book". Once you get the knack of their zoning system, it's a great tool to get started. I like the common-sense approach to

design (the author tells you of his past mistakes so you don't repeat them; like creating beds with very curvy borders and the problems associated with the curves). If you get this, you'll still need the Sunset Western Garden Book (or something like it) to teach you how to care for the plants you choose.
