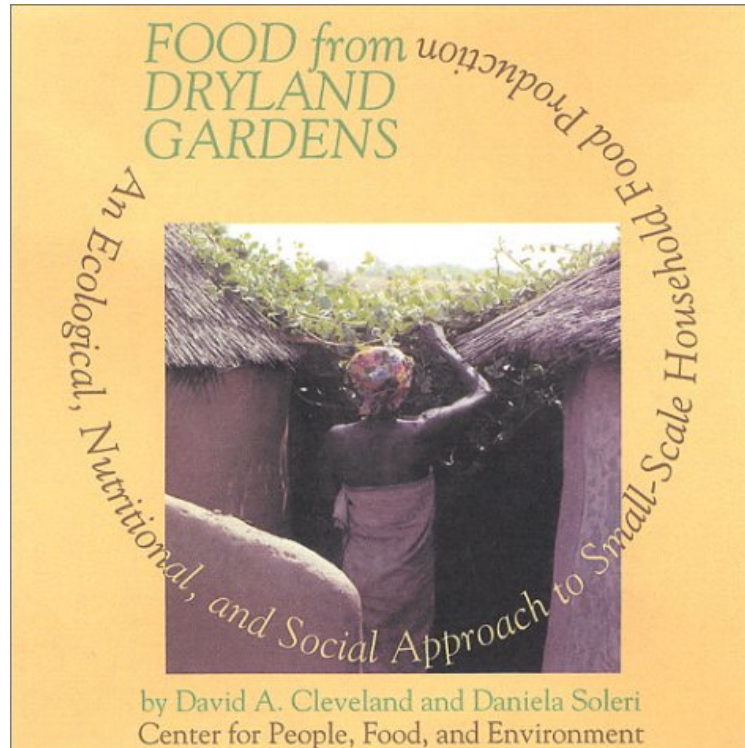

Aimed at intelligent and motivated readers who might nevertheless lack education and money, it conveys complex botanical information clearly and simply, and advises on every aspect of gardening, from building soil to preserving harvests, including how to improvise gardening tools, planters, and plant protection from whatever one can scavenge. It concentrates on the needs of those who live in less-than-ideal land for growing food: the drylands of the world. Unlike so many gardening books today, it does not emphasize what to buy but rather what you can accomplish without buying. I have found it incredibly useful, and I imagine that the CD-Rom is even more useful than that. I passionately recommend this work!

Food from Dryland Gardens encourages gardens that are based on local and scientific knowledge, conserve resources, and improve nutritional, economic, and social well-being. Both a beginners guide and reference for the experienced, it is being used around the world by extension agents, students, and project workers.
