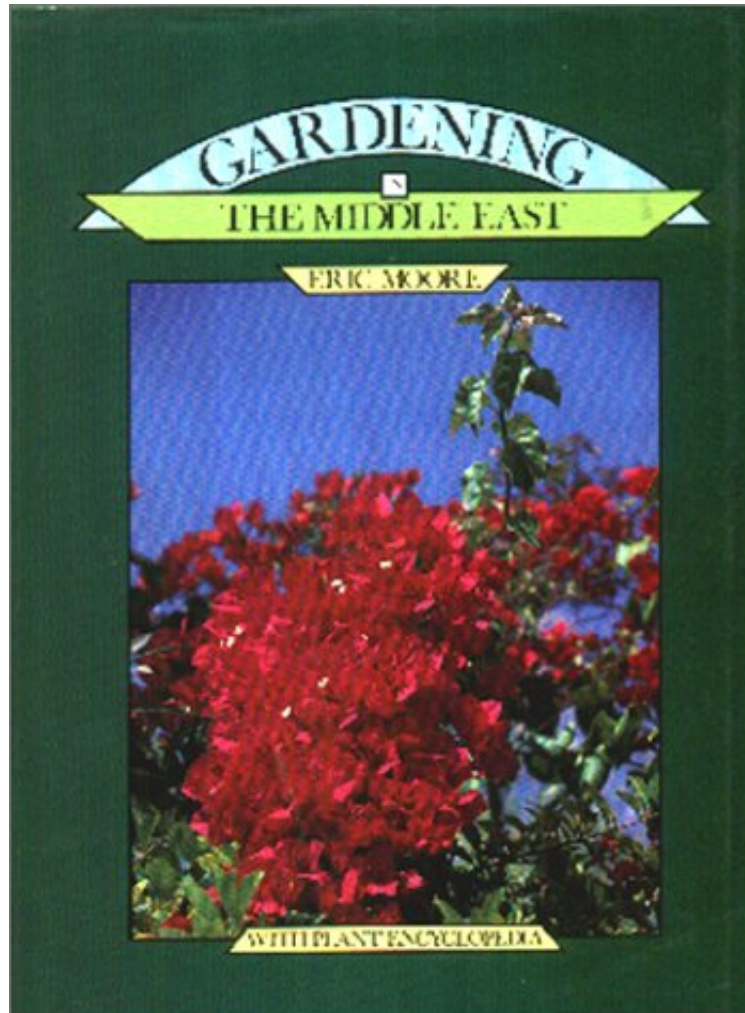

It is easily accessible to any novice or intermediate-level gardener. It's useful to me, even while I reside in central Florida, which has similar sandy soil and weather conditions as certain areas of the Middle East. Keep in mind, it was originally published in 1986, so some scientific names may have changed. It is still a relevant book.
