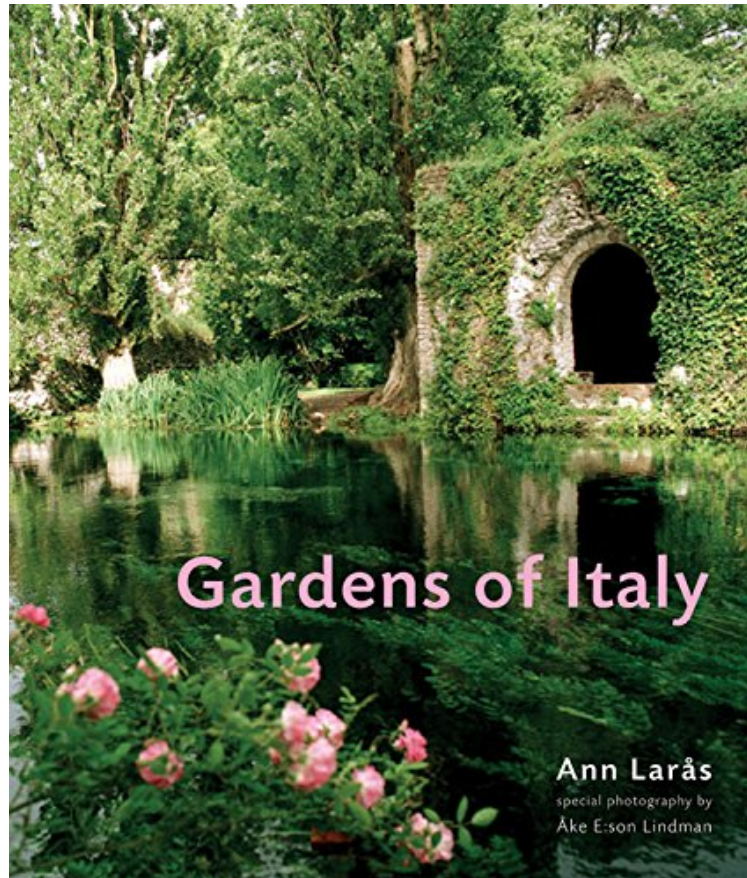

This inspirational book is an illustrated survey of more than 60 major gardens in Italy, from the lakes north of Milan
