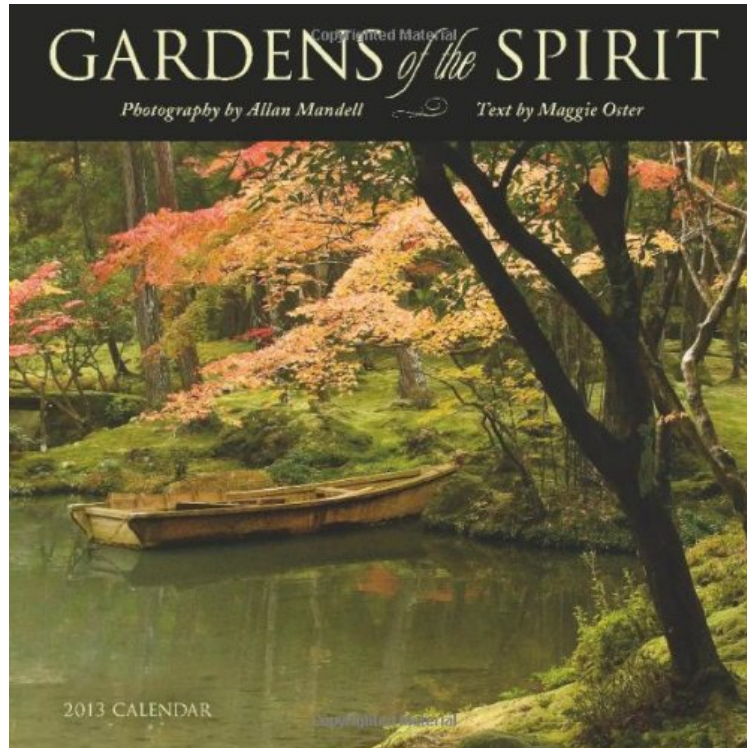

Every image is perfectly focused from the leaves "under your feet" to the trees well behind the main subject matter. Very impressed with number and range of holidays, and other facts that are listed. I hope Charles Mann creates a Hawaii calendar for 2013. Calendar is printed by Amber Lotus, on recycled paper using soy-based inks. The size of the day boxes look pretty standard to me, but I don't intend to write in the approximately 1.5" x 1.75" day boxes so their size is fine. All we need is room enough for the dog's monthly heartworm and flea med. stickers. Could have done without the long-winded comment at the bottom of the page completely.
